NOTICE

National Bylaws Article One, Section 150, Parliamentary Authority states:
The rules contained in the current addition of *“Robert’s Rules of Order, Newly Revised”* shall govern the Marine Corps League assemblies in all cases to which they are applicable and which they are not inconsistent or in conflict of with these Bylaws and Administrative Procedures and any special rules of order that the Marine Corps League may adopt.

“Robert’s Rules of Order, 10th Edition, Section IX, §35” related to a motion to *Amend Something Previously Adopted* will be followed to make proposed changes to the Detachment 186 Bylaws.

1. Previous Notice is required. Notice of the proposed changes will be introduced at a regularly scheduled meeting and tabled for a vote at the next regularly scheduled meeting.
2. The proposed changes will be voted on and adopted upon a majority vote of the members in good standing present at the meeting.

PROPOSED CHANGES

Article VI: Officers

(d) The terms of office shall be for the period of time between yearly elections (one year). An office is secured once the officer has been sworn into office.

(The following will be deleted from Article VI (d) of the Bylaws)

The Commandant may serve a total of two (2) consecutive terms in office. He/She shall be eligible to run again after a minimum of one (1) year. All other officers shall have no term limits. A partial term of office shall not be considered as a term of office.

(The following will be added to Article VI (d) of the Bylaws)

The term of office for all officers, both elected and appointed, shall be for a period of one (1) year and may serve as many additional consecutive terms as elected or appointed by the membership.

Article XIII: Committees

(d) The required standing committees are as follows:

1. Marine Corps Birthday Ball Committee
2. Ceremonial Committee
3. Membership Application Committee
4. Finance Committee (Added)



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(f) The Finance Committee shall be appointed by the Commandant and consist of a Chairman and two committee members. The Finance Committee will meet quarterly with the Detachment Paymaster (March, June, September and December) to review the Detachment's accounts and accounting procedures and report their findings to the Detachment Board of Trustees. The Finance Committee will monitor the Detachment's financial procedures and adherence to the filing schedule requirements of Federal, State and Local tax laws. The Finance Committee will perform an annual in depth audit of the Detachment's books and report their findings to the Board of Trustees.
